Leap card Information:

Young Adult and Student Card

The Young Adult (age 19-23) and Student Leap Card gives **reductions of 50%** compared to adult fares.

- The **Young Adult (19-23) Leap Card** is available to all 19 to 23 year olds right up to their 24th birthday.
- The **Student Leap Card** remains available to students in full-time education (including further education and training) who are either 16-18 or 24 years old and above.
- Students must have a minimum of 16 hours of lectures/class time per week, and be enrolled in the course for a minimum of 6 months.
- Full time international students who meet the above criteria are also entitled to apply for the SLC whilst in Ireland.
- Students enrolled as trainee Accountants (ACCA, Institute of Chartered Accountants in Ireland), trainee Solicitors registered with the Law Society, full time SOLAS trainees/students and full time PLC students are also considered eligible.
- Students of on-line courses are not eligible to apply for the SLC, unless they meet the criteria set out here.
- Students may be required to produce further evidence of eligibility (i.e. letter from college/institution), upon request by SLC or an agent of SLC
