| Purposes of processing | <p>If you choose to use our Wi-Fi service, we will process some of your personal data in order for you to access and use the service. Some device information, including location analytics, is processed for the purposes of system security and identifying where we need to improve Wi-Fi coverage. Data collected for location analytics purposes is irreversibly anonymised upon collection.</p> <p>Carlow College, St Patrick's is the controller of Wi-Fi data.</p> |
| Personal data which is processed | <p>We will process device and connection information, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ IP address – unique address that identified a device on the internet ▪ MAC address – a device's unique hardware number ▪ Client hostname – the name assigned to a device ▪ Bandwidth usage and download capacity of device ▪ Date/time of last connection <p>Web browsing history is not captured.</p> |
| Legal basis | <p>Processing of this data is necessary for the College's legitimate interests.</p> |
| Recipients of data | <p>Carlow College does not normally share this data, however, it may be shared as required or permitted by law or court order.</p> |
| Retention period | <p>Data is retained for a maximum period of 14 months. Shorter retention periods apply to some subsets.</p> |
| Is it obligatory to supply this data and what are the consequences of not supplying it? | <p>If you wish to use the Wi-Fi service, you are required to supply your data.</p> |
| Data Protection rights | <p>The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) gives you the following rights, with restrictions in some circumstances:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ To receive information about how we process your data ▪ Access to data ▪ Rectification of incomplete or incorrect data ▪ Erasure of data ▪ Restriction of data processing ▪ To object to data processing ▪ Data portability ▪ Rights in relation to automated decision-making, including profiling |
